
CHURCH AT LAODICEA ENDED CHURCH AGE... And thus ends the "things which are"

What does this mean? Another open door...with a "trumpet-like" invitation.




"But I do not want you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning those who have fallen asleep, lest you sorrow as others who have no hope. ¹⁴ For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so God will bring with Him those who sleep in Jesus.


¹⁵ For this we say to you by the word of the Lord, that we who are alive *and* remain until the coming of the Lord will by no means precede those who are asleep. ¹⁶ For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and <u>with the trumpet of God</u>. And the dead in Christ will rise first. ¹⁷ Then we who are alive *and* remain shall be <u>caught up</u> together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus we shall always be with the Lord. ¹⁸ Therefore comfort one another with these words." This event is what has come to be called the **"Rapture"** of the Church. Rapture is from the Latin "rapturo." The original Greek word is *harpazo*, which literally means to **"seize**, or **snatch away**." It is the word that our English has translated "<u>caught up</u>." the "catching up" of true believers...

- **1. PRE-TRIBULATION**




"Immediately I was in the Spirit... Perhaps similar to "in the twinkling of an eye?" Place of unique fellowship with God.

Now in the "Throne Room" of heaven Word "throne" appears 45X. God's throne center of all activity – everywhere.

"A glorious high throne from the beginning is the place of our sanctuary." (Jeremiah 17:12) Jasper – probably diamond – PURITY Last stone in High Priest's breastplate (Exodus 28:20) Sardius – Red – BLOOD OF THE LAMB Rainbow – Gr. Iris, can also be halo ONE on the throne <u>beyond description</u>. John doesn't even try.

Introduced to various aspects of the throne room....one at a time.





24 elders – "Elders" (*presbuteros*) meant the most mature (not necessarily the oldest) of believers in the church - *Paul's letters to Titus and Timothy addressed qualifications.*

White robes – spotless robes of righteousness, given by Jesus

Crowns of gold – (Stephanos)

crown of victory

(not diadema,

crown of authority, kingship)



Crown of <u>life</u> (James 1:12, Revelation 2:10) Crown of <u>righteousness</u> (2 timothy 4:8) Crown of <u>glory</u> (1 Peter 5:4) Crown <u>incorruptible</u> (1 Corinthians 9:25) Crown of <u>rejoicing</u> (1 Thessalonians 2:19) Crown of <u>gold</u> (Revelation 4:4)

ANGELS DO NOT WEAR CROWNS! Never promised to them.

QUESTION: WHO ARE THESE "ELDERS?" Angels? NO!

CLUES...

- 1. King David: organized 24 courses of priests, when all assembled, represented entire priesthood.
- 2. Believers called "priests" (Rev. 1:6)
- 3. Singing "song of the redeemed" (ch. 5:9)
- 4. 12 Tribes of Israel + 12 Disciples = 24
- 5. Elders mature believers



Already have crowns...

So much discussion over identity of these elders. It's really very simple when you keep the cardinal rule of interpretation:

CARDINAL RULE...

Always rely on scripture to interpret scripture!



Lightnings, thunderings, voices -

Consider His power, majesty, awesome nature!

Exodus 19:16: Then it came to pass on the third day, in the morning, that there were <u>thunderings and lightnings</u>, and a thick cloud on the mountain; and the sound of the trumpet was very loud, so that all the people who *were* in the camp trembled.

Exodus 20:18: Now all the people witnessed the <u>thunderings</u>, the lightning flashes, the sound of the trumpet, and the mountain smoking; and when the people saw *it*, they trembled and stood afar off.

2 Samuel 22:15: He sent out arrows and scattered them; <u>Lightning</u> bolts, and He vanquished them.

Job 36:32: He covers *His* hands with <u>lightning</u>, And commands it to strike.

Job 37:2: Hear attentively <u>the thunder of His voice</u>, And the rumbling that comes from His mouth.

Lightnings, thunderings, voices -

Consider His power, majesty, awesome nature!

Job 37:3: He sends it forth under the whole heaven, His <u>lightning</u> to the ends of the earth.

Job 38:35: Can you send out <u>lightnings</u>, that they may go, And say to you, 'Here we *are!*'?

Job 39:19: "Have you given the horse strength? Have you <u>clothed</u> <u>his neck with thunder</u>?

Job 40:9: Have you an arm like God? Or <u>can you thunder with a</u> <u>voice like His</u>?

Psalm 18:14: He sent out His arrows and scattered the foe, Lightnings in abundance, and He vanquished them.

Psalm 77:18: The voice of Your thunder was in the whirlwind; The lightnings lit up the world; The earth trembled and shook. Psalm 78:48: He also gave up their cattle to the hail, And their

flocks to fiery lightning.

Lightnings, thunderings, voices -

Consider His power, majesty, awesome nature!

Psaim 81:7: You called in trouble, and I delivered you; I answered you in the secret place of thunder; I tested you at the waters of Meribah. Selah

Psalm 97:4: His <u>lightnings light the world</u>; The earth sees and trembles.

Psalm 104:7: At Your rebuke they fled; At the voice of Your thunder they hastened away.

Psalm 135:7: He causes the vapors to ascend from the ends of the earth; He makes <u>lightning</u> for the rain; He brings the wind out of His treasuries.

Psalm 144:6: Flash forth <u>lightning</u> and scatter them; Shoot out Your arrows and destroy them.

Lightnings, thunderings, voices -

Consider His power, majesty, awesome nature!

Isaiah 29:6: You will be punished by the Lord of hosts With <u>thunder and earthquake and great noise</u>, With storm and tempest And the flame of devouring fire.

Jeremiah 10:13 When He utters His voice, *There is* a multitude of waters in the heavens: "And He causes the vapors to ascend from the ends of the earth. He makes <u>lightning</u> for the rain, He brings the wind out of His treasuries."

Jeremiah 51:16: When He utters *His* voice— *There is* a multitude of waters in the heavens: "He causes the vapors to ascend from the ends of the earth; He makes <u>lightnings</u> for the rain; He brings the wind out of His treasuries."

Ezekiel 1:13: As for the likeness of the living creatures, their appearance *was* like burning coals of fire, like the appearance of torches going back and forth among the living creatures. The fire was bright, and <u>out of the fire went lightning</u>.

Lightnings, thunderings, voices -

Consider His power, majesty, awesome nature!

Ezekiel 1:14: And the living creatures ran back and forth, in appearance <u>like a flash of lightning</u>. Daniel 10:6: His body *was* like beryl, his face <u>like the appearance</u>

of lightning, his eyes like torches of fire, his arms and feet like burnished bronze in color, and the sound of his words like the <u>voice</u> of a multitude.

Zechariah 9:14 Then the Lord will be seen over them, And His arrow will <u>go forth like lightning</u>. The Lord God will blow the trumpet, And go with whirlwinds from the south.

Matthew 24:27: For as the lightning comes from the east and flashes to the west, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be. Matthew 28:3 His countenance was like lightning, and his clothing as white as snow.

Lightnings, thunderings, voices -

Consider His power, majesty, awesome nature!

Luke 17:24: For as the <u>lightning that flashes out</u> of one *part* under heaven shines to the other *part* under heaven, so also the Son of Man will be in His day.

Revelation 4:5: And from the throne proceeded <u>lightnings</u>, <u>thunderings</u>, <u>and voices</u>. Seven lamps of fire *were* burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God.

Revelation 6:1: Now I saw when the Lamb opened one of the seals; and I heard one of the four living creatures saying with a <u>voice like thunder</u>, "Come and see."

Revelation 8:5: Then the angel took the censer, filled it with fire from the altar, and threw *it* to the earth. And there were <u>noises, thunderings, lightnings</u>, and an earthquake.

Lightnings, thunderings, voices -

Consider His power, majesty, awesome nature!

Revelation 11:19: Then the temple of God was opened in heaven, and the ark of His covenant was seen in His temple. And there were lightnings, noises, thunderings, an earthquake, and great hail. Revelation 14:2: And I heard a voice from heaven, like the voice of many waters, and like the voice of loud thunder. And I heard the sound of harpists playing their harps.

Revelation 16:18: And there were <u>noises and thunderings and</u> <u>lightnings</u>; and there was a great earthquake, such a mighty and great earthquake as had not occurred since men were on the earth.

Revelation 19:6: And I heard, as it were, the voice of a great multitude, as the sound of many waters and as the sound of <u>mighty thunderings</u>, saying, "Alleluia! For the Lord God Omnipotent reigns!





"Sea of glass...."

• Difficult to picture.

- OT reference to the Laver in courtyard of Tabernacle/Temple, place for priests to ritually purify themselves
- WATCH FOR THE WORD "LIKE" John 1st century man trying to describe things in the future, or things he has never seen before. Word "like" keeps us from being too literal.
- STRANGE "LIVING CREATURES" 4 of them, number represents creation, human government (4 ordinal directions, etc.)











A little "side trip" into the Old Testament...

The book of Revelation ties all the pieces together. "So He drove out the man; and He placed <u>cherubim</u> at the east of the garden of Eden, and a flaming sword which turned every way, to guard the way to the tree of life." *(keroob, ?)* (Genesis 3:24) 91X – 66 verses

"Above it stood <u>seraphim</u>; each one had six wings: with two he covered his face, with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew." (saraph, "fiery") (Isaiah 6:2) 7X – 7verses

Ezekiel Chs 1 and 10 – "living creatures"

 Praising 24/7






Rabbinical Precision

- The Camp of Judah: East of Levites
- The Camp of Reuben: South
- The Camp of Ephraim: West
- The Camp of Dan: North
- Strict obedience denies all areas not strictly "cardinal directions" – North, East, South, West
- Only width of Levite's camp allowed
- Length proportional to population
















- Living creatures give <u>glory</u>, <u>honor</u>, <u>thanks</u>
- 24 elders cast their crowns (throw, intense)
- Everything, everyone praising
- "You are worthy..."
- "...to receive <u>glory</u>, <u>honor</u>, power..."

- "glory" doxa, lit. honor resulting from a good opinion (something very apparent) – good report, fame, reputation (Hebrew, kavod [kabod]), "weighty" (honor, respect? – the highest?)
- "Honor" time, lit. value, highest esteem
- "thanks" eucharistia, grateful language to God, to receive something as an expression of grace, as if not deserved
- "power" dunamis, inherent power, authority, force
- "worship" proskuneo, prostrated adoration

"For you created all things, and by Your will they exist and were created." (4:11)

THE ANSWER TO THE AGE OLD QUESTIONS:

- Why was I created? Why am I here? What is my purpose?
- We were created by his [desire, pleasure, will]
- No mistakes, no accidents, always with purpose
- What purpose? To:
 - ✓ Glorify reveal Him
 - ✓ Magnify praise Him
 - ✓ Worship adore Him

TO GLORIFY...

- to think, suppose, be of opinion
- to praise, extol, magnify, celebrate
- to honor, do honor to, hold in honor
- to make glorious, adorn with luster, clothe with splendor
- to impart glory to something, render it excellent
- to make renowned, render illustrious
- to cause the dignity and worth of some person or thing to become manifest and acknowledged (to reveal God!)
