Revelation 14

- The Lamb and 144,000, Announcing Angels, Great harvests, The Winepress
- Lamb seen on Mount Zion, with 144,000, Father's name on their foreheads.
- Multitude with harps sing a "new song" in heaven. Only 144,000 and redeemed could learn this song. 144,000 Identified as "virgins" and follow the Lamb wherever He goes.
- "Redeemed from among men" said to be "firstfruits" to God and the Lamb. No deceit in their mouths, "without fault" before throne of God.
- Another flying angel in "the midst of heaven" with the "everlasting gospel to preach" to every nation, tribe, tongue and people. Angel announces "Fear God and give glory to Him, for the hour of His

Judgment has come; and worship Him..." (the last judgments are coming)

- Another angel followed saying "Babylon is fallen...because she has made all nations drink of the wine of the wrath of her fornication."
- 3rd angel says if anyone worship the beast/image, and receives his mark, they will "drink of the wine of wrath of God" (poured out full strength!) and be tormented forever. Clear warning—don't take the mark of the beast!
- Change in tone, "the patience of the saints" - "blessed are the dead who die in the Lord from now on." They will rest.

- Now John sees a white cloud, and "One like the Son of Man" sits on the cloud, golden crown on His head, holding sharp sickle. Another angel comes out of the temple in heaven and tells the "One" on the cloud to "thrust in your sickle and reap...the time has come...the harvest of the earth is ripe." And the earth is reaped. This is 1st harvest in this chapter (believers)
- Yet another angel comes from temple in heaven also with sharp sickle. And another angel (the 6th one in this chapter), who had "power over fire" (altar of incense, prayers of the saints), gives similar command to "thrust in your sharp sickle and gather the clusters of the vine of the earth, for her grapes are fully ripe." (evil has reached its peak). Angel does so, throws into the "great winepress of the wrath of God." (Matthew 13:37-43)
- Winepress is trampled "outside the city" and blood came out up to the horses bridles, 1600 furlongs (approx 180 miles, length of valley of Megiddo). See Isaiah 63:1-4, Joel 3:9-15

(NOTE: This chapter is almost impossible to decipher completely. May be seen as another "overview" of the rest of the book. Like chapter 6 is somewhat of an overview of the entire book.)
